**What is the Council of the North?**

It is a ministry of General Synod of the Anglican Church of Canada. Its purpose is to provide pastoral and sacramental ministry to all who are living in isolated communities in Canada's North including the Arctic, Yukon, Caledonia, Athabasca, Saskatchewan, Brandon, Keewatin, Moosonee, and Quebec.

It covers 85% of the geography of Canada and 15% of the population of Canada. The council faces many challenges in its quest for effective ministry including travel; translation from English into indigenous languages of worship material and church documents; training for ministry; allocation of resources; support for indigenous people.

The Council is a ministry of the Whole Church by the Whole Church.

**PWRDF Pakistan Floods Relief Fund**

In collaboration with members of the Canadian Churches in Action, an alliance of ten Canadian Church-based organizations, PWRDF will be applying to access the "Pakistan Floods Relief Fund" from the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) to support ongoing relief work in Pakistan.

Designated donations made to PWRDF from August 2, 2010 to end of day September 12, 2010 and receipted through parishes or directly by PWRDF will be eligible for the Government of Canada to contribute an equivalent amount to the "Pakistan Floods Relief Fund", which will be administered separately by CIDA. The government announced that CIDA will use the Pakistan Floods Relief Fund to provide assistance through experienced Canadian and international humanitarian and development organizations with significant in-country capacity, as per established channels and procedures.
